Orwell's "Such, Such Were the Joys.": Alienation and Other Such Joys George Orwell expresses a feeling of alienation throughout "Such, Such Were the Joys."

Gordon sees desolation and prophecies of doom behind the seemingly optimistic manifestations of life on the advertising posters: Behind that slick self-satisfaction, that tittering fat-bellied triviality, there is nothing but a frightful emptiness, a secret despair. In Spain he lived for a while in a classless society and wrote enthusiastically about it and became convinced that it is possible for human beings of different classes to associate without prejudice. Though he shows his ability to enumerate what is "good," he resigns himself to a predestined state; uncertain of where exactly he fits in society, his attitude is irreconcilable with what he knows society expects of him. Do you? The war made life difficult for the school – most of the teaching staff left to fight, [14] although one staff member Charles Edgar Loseby, later a Labour MP, returned for a period while recovering from being gassed in the trenches. Orwell approves of the working-class attitude towards education because, as he says, they see through it and reject it. By the end of that term his teeth were an extraordinary shade of green. Both mean spanners and smashed faces. How much money did you bring back with you? Moreover, except for a minority who were really useful, there were many minor officials who knew that their job could be done just as well by natives, and this gave them a sense of futility. She was frankly capricious. A few months later Elizabeth marries Mr. She refuses him and goes back to a life of drudgery and petty respectability, but she has now lost her faith and must find some justification for her hard work in the gratification to be derived from a well-done task. A very small boy named Ronalds, aged no more than about ten, who was implicated in some way, was being flogged, or was recovering from a flogging. How many shows did you go to in the hols? I turned away unconcernedly and then, as though my legs were doing it of their own accord, broke into a clumsy run. Life, if the grave really ends it, is monstrous and dreadful. Down in the safe soft womb of earth, where there is no getting of jobs or losing of jobs, no relatives or friends to plague you, no hope, fear, ambitions, honour, duty – no duns of any kind. Orwell's "Such, Such Were the Joys The degeneracy was already a noticeable feature before the First World War and is due ultimately to unhealthy ways of living generated by industrialism. A maxim often repeated to us at St Cprian's was that it is healthy to get up from a meal feeling as hungry as when you sat down. It is all or nothing.
